ITINERARY

Day 1: Singapore / New Delhi (No meals)

Assemble at Changi Airport for flight to Delhi the capital of Modern India, later on arrival at International airport, meet and transfer to hotel for overnight at Hotel in Delhi.



Days 2: Delhi - Srinagar (Kashmir) (Breakfast / Lunch / Dinner)

Morning after breakfast transfer to Domestic airport for a flight to Srinagar, the Summer capital of Kashmir at the height of 5200 ft above sea level, which is located on the foot of Himalayan Mountains, A Kashmiri warm welcome greets you on arrival from airport to jetty by cars and after which transfer to Premium Deluxe Houseboats anchored on the famous Dal lake via Gondolas better known locally as



Shikaras. After lunch at your houseboat later return to Srinagar, cruise on Dal Lake in these shikaras visiting the Floating garden, Lotus gardens (Summers), back waters of the lake, cruise will go through canals look for pure Pashmina Shawl while you are in Kashmir. Return to houseboat in the evening. Dinner and stay at Bostan Premium Deluxe Houseboat. (4*)

Day 3: Srinagar – Gulmarg - Srinagar (Breakfast / Lunch / Dinner)



After breakfast enjoy an excursion to **Gulmarg** (Meadow of Flowers) at a height of 8800ft above sea level. Enroute visit **Orphanage Center** and interact with local orphan children and you can make donation if you like at local office, here you will witness the beauty of Nature surroundings of Kashmir valley, Gulmarg used to be a favorite hunt of the British in

summers and you will find old colonial flavoured hotels and shops around the Meadows. One can also have the view of Nanga Parbhat (26,600 ft) if weather permits. Gulmarg has highest 18 hole golf course in the world and has developed into a famous Ski resort. Take a gondola ride (**Cable car ride**) 1st Phase from 8800 ft to 10,200 ft to Kongdori high above the meadows and snow covered slopes of Apherwat and Khilanmarg mountain at 10,200 ft above sea level. Afternoon return to Srinagar. Dinner and night stay at Houseboat.

Day 4: Srinagar (Breakfast / Lunch / Dinner)



After breakfast, tour of Srinagar city and visit **Jammia Masjid** the **biggest Mosque in Kashmir** 670 years old with beautiful architecture with influence from **Chinese pagoda style** as Kashmir was on the caravan Silk route between China and India and explore the local bazaar for spices have heritage walk in Old town Srinagar later visit famous Mughal Gardens situated on the banks of Dal lake

with Zaberwan mountain range on the back ground and Lake Dal on the fore ground visit **Nishat garden** (Garden of Pleasure) built by Asif Khan brother in law of Jahangir in 1632 AD overlooking the crystal clear Emerald green waters of the Dal lake then to **Shalimar** (Garden of Love) built by Mughal Emperor Jahangir for his wife Empress Noor Jehan. During spring until autumn these gardens are full of flowers. Also pay a visit to Kashmir Famous Hand knotted Silk carpet weaving factory for good bargains, visit Papier-mâché work, walnut wood work centre. Return to houseboat in the evening. Dinner and night stay at Premium Deluxe Houseboat.

Day 5: Srinagar - Sonamarg - Srinagar (Breakfast / Lunch / Dinner)

Depart morning after breakfast for a wonderful trip with **Picnic lunch** to Sonamarg (Meadow of Gold) at a distance of 86 kms, situated at a height of 8900 feet above sea level. The distance is covered in 3 hours approx. and drive up to Sonamarg which goes along the Sindh River. It is also known as the Sindh



Valley. The drive is very spectacular with beautiful sceneries along the way, enroute stop at **Kangan town**, an interesting small mountain town where mountain people from the surrounding valleys come down for trading. Once you reach Sonamarg you will feel like you are in the **Swiss Alps**. The meadows of Sonamarg have a spectacular beauty from the strewn with the loveliest of **Alpine flowers**, lots of **Fir** and pine and **silver birch trees**. Your drive during winter will go up to snow point and enjoy Picnic lunch, explore the Sonamarg valley and enjoy walking to the beautiful view points on foot or on ponies (own expenses) to **ThajwasGalaciers** during early summers you will witness the Mountain people Like Gujars and Phul mountain people taking herds of Sheep and goats towards the higher pastures for summer season. Late afternoon return back to Srinagar. **Farewell Kashmiri dinner** awaits you at houseboats. Night stay at your houseboat

Day 06: Srinagar - Delhi - Jaipur (Breakfast / Lunch / Dinner)

Morning after leisurely breakfast enjoy some time on the front porch of your houseboat and witness the activities around the lake area as the World goes by and later transfer to airport for flight to Delhi. On arrival in Delhi Drive to Jaipur 245 Km about 5 and half hours drive. Arrive in Jaipur. Check in hotel. Dinner and overnight stay at hotel.



Day 7: Jaipur (Breakfast / Lunch / Dinner)



After breakfast visit Amber **Fort** the capital of the state for six centuries before Jaipur was built. It is set on a steep hill and the palace is laid down at different levels on hillsides and encircled by Fortress. Also enjoy the **Elephant ride** or jeep ride up to the fort, later tour takes us to **Hawa Mahal** or Palace of Winds. It was built in 1799 by Pratap Singh and was royal Grandstand for

Palace women to view the city in privacy. Photo stop, visit **City Palace**, was the principal residence of the former ruling family and is known for its stunning architecture, later drive to **Samodh 45 KM**. Tourists can explore the rugged terrain of the Great Indian **Desert of Thar using camels**. The Aravallis are one of the world's oldest mountain ranges. Samode is surrounded by sandy fields, small dunes, and beautiful hills and offers ample opportunities to witness mesmerizing sunrises and sunsets. Enjoy the **camel safaris in Samode**. Will take you to the destinations where you will witness small villages along the way and watch village folk go about their daily life. During crop harvesting, the views are exceptionally enticing. Evening return back to Jaipur for overnight stay.

Day 8: Jaipur - Agra (Breakfast / Lunch / Dinner) (232 kms - 5 hours)



After breakfast drive to Agra –the capital city of the Mughal emperors. On arrival check in hotel. After lunch at hotel visit World famous **Taj Mahal**, one of the **Seven Wonders of the World**. Mughal Emperor Shah Jehan built this Marble monument of love in 1653 in memory of his beloved Queen Mumtaz Mahal to enshrine her mortal remains. The construction work took

22 years to be completed with 20 thousand workers, **also** visit the Agra **Fort**, a red sand stone fort built by Akbar the Great in 1565 and completed by grandson Shah Jehan. Later witness the skilled craftsmen doing fine Marble inlay work. Dinner over night stay at hotel.



Day 9 Agra – Delhi (165Kms) – Departure to Singapore
(Breakfast / Lunch / Dinner)

After breakfast drive to Delhi 175 kms, approx. 4 hours, on arrival **lunch** at **North Indian tandoori restaurant** followed by visit drive pass **India Gate** 42 meter high memorial arch is a tribute to the 90,000 Indian Soldiers killed during World War 1 and Afghan War, drive pass by Parliament House, President Palace built in 1929 once the imperial residence of the British



Viceroy's and official residence of the President of India, visit **QutubMinar**(Tower of victory) 72.5 meter high memorial, Monument in Delhi and listed as **Unesco World Heritage** site high memorial built by Qutub'd Din in **1193 A.D.** immediately after the defeat of Delhi's last Hindu kingdom located in new Delhi visit famous **Lotus temple** is a Bahá'í House of Worship completed in 1986. Notable for its flower like shape, it serves as the Mother Temple of the Indian subcontinent and has become a prominent attraction in the city. Later shopping at Connaught Place and Jan path Market, **Chinese Dinner** at restaurant thereafter transfers to International Airport for your flight departure to Singapore.
