Day 1: Chiang Rai Arrival (Dinner)

On arrival into Chiang Rai Airport, you will be met by a local guide and transferred to your selected hotel. Welcome dinner at the hotel

Day 2: Chiang Rai Sightseeing Tour (Breakfast / Lunch Dinner)



The city of Chiang Rai, located near the intersection of Thailand, Myanmar (Burma) and Laos, is rich in history, culture and diversity. Experience it yourself with this four-hour tour of the city, available in the morning or the afternoon.

Get picked up from your hotel to begin your tour at Wat Rong Khun, known as the **White Temple**: designed by one of Thailand's most famous artists - Chalermchai Kositpipat - this unique temple is white with small glass pieces that shimmer in the sun, representing the purity and wisdom of the Buddha.

Next, learn about some of the surrounding areas at the **Hill Tribe Museum**, where you can explore exhibits touching on the area's long history of opium and the effect it has had on the lives of the mountain people and hill tribe villages.



Finally, wrap up your tour with a visit to **Wat Phra Kaew**, Chiang Rai's very own Temple of the Emerald Buddha, which features the most highly-revered Buddha image (also enshrined in the Wat Phra Kaew temple on the grounds of the Grand Palace in Bangkok). Explore this historical temple, which dates back to the time of Chiang Rai's founding, before heading off to explore more of the city and its surrounding area on your own. Lunch at local restaurant before continue the

Blue temple, new landmark of temple architecture renovated from ancient temple since 100 years ago by local artist. And then, hop to **Baan Dam (Black House)**, unique creation of national artist, Thawan Duchanee. Part art studio, part museum, part home, Baan Dam is an eclectic mix of traditional northern Thai buildings interspersed with some outlandish modern designs.

Lunch and Dinner at local restaurant.

Day 3: Chiang Rai Golden Triangle Tour (Breakfast / Lunch / Dinner)



After a morning pick up from hotel in Chiang Rai city area, drive to Chiang Saen and the **Golden Triangle** where Thailand, Myanmar and Laos meet at the confluence of the Mekong and Ruak Rivers.



Visit the scenic viewpoint at the Golden Triangle to look over these three countries before heading to the **Hall of Opium** (closed every Monday). This interactive museum provides a fascinating insight into the region's production of opium. Lunch is at a local restaurant before driving uphill to visit **Doi Tung Royal Project**, Hall of Inspiration and Mae Fah Luang Garden. Doi Tung Royal Project is a sustainable project founded by Princess Mother of King Rama IX aiming to support communities in Chiang Rai.

Learn more about their development work before heading to an Akha hill tribe village called **Ban Lorcha**. This community-based tourism (CBT) project at Ban Lorcha was established in the mid-1990s and is owned by the village bank. This form of management ensures that no one in the village can dominate tourism activity for selfish purposes. Through this CBT project, all households at Ban Lorcha have an equal opportunity for participating and earning money from tourism activities. Afterwards, return to the hotel.

Special Notes:

Trail Condition: Easy walk and wheelchairs friendly except Akha Lor Cha where it's up & downhill in village (not suitable for wheelchairs)

Fitness Level Requirement: All Levels

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

Day 4: Chiang Rai Departure (Breakfast)

After breakfast in hotel, it is free and easy until time for transfer to Chiang Rai Airport for your flight departure to Singapore.
