Visit Tirta Empul Temple in Tampak Siring – the holy spring water where the Balinese people use it for their purification ritual. Have your time here to experience this Balinese water purification ritual before heading to Kintamani for lunch with breath-taking view of Batur lake. On your way back to Legian, get to best view that is only a short hike away, at the serene and less-frequented Tegalalang Rice Terraces.

In the afternoon, we will continue to Arma Museum for a creative fun and educating workshop. Travelers will learn to make offerings from leaves, bamboo, and flowers.

Moreover, discover why offerings are important for the Hindu Balinese. Complete the day by having dinner together.
