### PROPOSED ITINERARY - OKINAWA

## ***DAY 02 : MARINE ADVENTURES & HISTORICAL SITES (BREAKFAST / LUNCH / DINNER)***

*Day two takes you into the underwater world of Okinawa with a visit to Busena Marine Park. This park offers a unique marine experience through its glass-bottom boat and Underwater Observatory Tower. These attractions allow visitors to witness the vibrant marine life of Okinawa without getting wet. The clear waters surrounding the park provide breathtaking views of colourful fish and coral reefs.*

*After enjoying the marine park, you'll have lunch at a local restaurant before stopping at the Kouri Ohashi Bridge for a photo opportunity. This impressive bridge connects the main island of Okinawa to Kouri Island and offers stunning views of the crystal-clear sea.*



*Next, visit the Nakijin Castle ruins, another UNESCO World Heritage Site, which played an important role in Okinawa's ancient history. The castle ruins are a beautiful and historic destination, with breathtaking views of the surrounding area.*

*The final stops of the day are the Pineapple Park, where you can learn about Okinawa's pineapple farming and indulge in pineapple-themed products, and Okashigoten, famous for its traditional Okinawan sweets. The day wraps up with a dinner at a local restaurant.*

***DAY 03 : CULTURAL IMMERSION & CITY LIFE  
(BREAKFAST / LUNCH / DINNER)***

Here, you'll participate in Shisa Painting, a hands-on activity where you paint your own Shisa, Okinawa's guardian lion-dog figures that symbolize protection.*

*At 10 am, you'll have the chance to watch an Eisa Folk Dance Show, a traditional Okinawan performance with drums and dynamic choreography. Following this cultural immersion, have lunch at a local restaurant.*

*The afternoon will take you to American Village, a vibrant entertainment and shopping district with a Western-style atmosphere. After some time exploring, transfer to Naha City and visit Kokusaidori Street, the bustling main street of*



Naha. Kokusaidori is lined with shops, restaurants, and markets, offering souvenirs and local delicacies. Dinner at a local restaurant.

**DAY 04 : HISTORICAL REFLECTION & SHOPPING  
(BREAKFAST / LUNCH / DINNER)**

On the fourth day, visit the Former Japanese Navy Underground Headquarters, a sobering and historically significant site where Japanese naval forces staged their operations during World War II. This underground maze offers insights into the island's war history.

Afterward, explore Ryukyu Glass Village, where traditional Okinawan glass-blowing techniques are on display. You can even try your hand at creating your own glassware as a unique souvenir.





Lunch is followed by a shopping spree at Ashibina Outlet Mall, a popular destination for discount shopping, and a visit to Umikaji Terrace, a stylish, modern shopping and dining complex with beautiful views of the ocean. Dinner will again be enjoyed at a local restaurant.

### DAY 05 : OKINAWA TO TAIPEI (BREAKFAST)

### DAY 05 : ARRIVAL TAIPEI – FREE & EASY

## DAY 06 : TAIPEI BEITOU & DANSHUI OLD STREET (BREAKFAST)

Start the day with morning breakfast in hotel. Proceed to Beitou Thermal Valley, one of Taiwan's most famous geothermal spots. Also known as "Hell Valley" because of its sulfuric waters and steam clouds rising from the earth, the area offers a truly unique landscape. Take the opportunity to experience Beitou's famous hot springs, so make sure to bring your swimsuit. Relax and rejuvenate as you soak in the mineral-rich waters, which are believed to have healing properties. Afterward, the itinerary takes you to Danshui Old Street, a historical neighbourhood known for its vibrant atmosphere, local street food, and traditional shops. Wander along the narrow streets and experience the local culture, tasting regional specialties like iron eggs and fish crackers. The day wraps up with a visit to Fisherman's Wharf, a scenic area by the sea. Known for its beautiful sunsets, the wharf is a popular spot for tourists and locals alike. The Lover's Bridge, an iconic landmark, offers stunning views and is a great place for an evening stroll before returning to your hotel.

## DAY 07 : SHIFEN – JIUFEN & TAIPEI 101 (BREAKFAST / LUNCH / DINNER)

After breakfast, your first destination is Shifen, famous for its sky lanterns. Here, you'll have the chance to write your wishes on a lantern and release it into the sky, following a long-standing Taiwanese tradition. The sight of colourful lanterns floating upwards is both peaceful and captivating. Next on the agenda is a visit to Jiufen, a picturesque town perched on a mountainside, known for its old-fashioned streets, teahouses, and vibrant atmosphere. This charming town was once a prosperous gold mining area



*and is now a popular tourist destination. The narrow alleyways are packed with unique shops selling local crafts, snacks, and souvenirs. Heping Island is another highlight of the day, offering stunning coastal views. The island is a scenic geological park with impressive rock formations and tranquil surroundings, ideal for a peaceful nature walk.*

*Finally, no trip to Taipei is complete without visiting Taipei 101. This iconic skyscraper was once the tallest building in the world and offers breathtaking panoramic views of the city from its observation deck (Entrance fee not included). You'll have the chance to explore this architectural marvel and, if time permits, enjoy some shopping at the high-end stores located within the tower before heading back to your hotel.*
