ITINERARY - EXPLORING OKINAWA

Okinawa, a tropical paradise in Japan, offers a harmonious blend of history, culture, natural beauty, and modern attractions. This 5-day itinerary is carefully crafted to immerse you in the island's rich heritage and breathtaking scenery, making your stay memorable.

DAY 01 – 25 MARCH – OKINAWA'S HISTORIC & COASTAL CHARM (LUNCH / DINNER)

Begin your tour with a visit to **Shuri Castle**, a UNESCO World Heritage Site and the former royal palace of the Ryukyu Kingdom. Head to Onna Village, known for its stunning coastline and relaxed atmosphere, before visiting Busena Marine Park, weather permitting. Enjoy a ride on the Glass Bottom Boat, offering a fascinating view of Okinawa's vibrant coral reefs and marine life. Climb the Underwater Observatory Tower to see colorful fish and coral habitats up close.

Conclude your day by checking into your hotel. Dinner in hotel or local restaurant.

DAY 02 – 26 MARCH – NORTHERN OKINAWA ADVENTURES (BREAKFAST / LUNCH / DINNER)

Start the day with a brief stop at **Kouri Ohashi Bridge**, an architectural marvel that spans the turquoise waters between Yagaji Island and Kouri Island. Take 20 minutes to snap photos of the scenic surroundings.

Next, visit the **Nakijin Castle Ruins**, another UNESCO World Heritage Site. These ruins, perched on a hill overlooking the sea, exude an ancient charm and provide insight into Okinawa's historical defense systems.

Continue to the world-famous Churaumi Aquarium, a must-visit attraction. Marvel at the massive Kuroshio Tank, home to majestic whale sharks and manta rays, and explore exhibits showcasing Okinawa's unique marine ecosystems.

Enjoy a buffet lunch at a local restaurant before heading to Pineapple Park, a fun and quirky destination dedicated to pineapples. Hop on a guided pineapple cart ride, sample pineapple-based treats, and shop for souvenirs.

End the day at Okashigoten, a popular confectionery store where you can taste and buy Okinawan sweets, including beni imo tarts made from purple sweet potatoes. Dinner in hotel or local restaurant.

DAY 03 – 27 MARCH – CULTURAL IMMERSION & MODERN ATTRACTIONS (BREAKFAST / LUNCH / DINNER)

Today, we visit Cape Manzamo, a dramatic cliff formation that offers panoramic views of the East China Sea. This iconic spot is perfect for photos, especially during sunrise or sunset.

Immerse yourself in Okinawan traditions at Ryukyu Village, where you can paint your own Shisa (guardian lion figurine), a symbol of protection and prosperity in Okinawan culture. Enjoy the Eisa Folk Dance Show, a vibrant performance showcasing Okinawan music and dance, starting at 10 a.m.

Lunch at local restaurant and enjoy a relaxing break before exploring the bustling American Village, a lively entertainment and shopping district with a Western-inspired vibe. Take time to explore its unique boutiques, cafes, and street art.

Conclude the day in Naha City, where you can wander along Kokusaidori Street, a bustling thoroughfare lined with souvenir shops, restaurants, and street food vendors. Sample fresh seafood or Okinawan donuts (sata andagi) for a sweet treat. Dinner at local restaurant.

DAY 04 - 28 MARCH - REFLECTION - SHOPPING - COASTL BEAUTY (BREAKFAST / LUNCH / DINNER)

Begin your day with a visit to the **Former Japanese Navy Underground Headquarters**, a historic site from World War II. Walk through the underground tunnels and learn about Okinawa's wartime history.

Continue to Ryukyu Glass Village, where you can watch artisans create vibrant handblown glassware or even try your hand at glass-making. This is an excellent place to purchase beautiful glass souvenirs.

Enjoy lunch at a local restaurant before heading to Ashibina Outlet Mall, a premium shopping destination offering discounted prices on high-end brands.

Spend your afternoon at Umikaji Terrace, a chic seaside shopping and dining complex with whitewashed buildings reminiscent of the Mediterranean. Take in stunning ocean views while enjoying a relaxing coffee or snack. End the day with a delightful dinner at a local restaurant.

DAY 05 – 29 MARCH – SALT FACTORY & SOUTHEAST BOTANICAL ILLUMINATION (BREAKFAST / LUNCH / DINNER)

This Okinawa itinerary offers a blend of scenic, cultural, and culinary experiences. Start by exploring the picturesque Sea Road, a stunning drive surrounded by ocean views. Visit the Salt Factory to learn about traditional Okinawan salt-making and sample unique varieties. Stop by Cake Kaho, a charming shop offering delectable local sweets. Enjoy a delicious lunch at a local restaurant, savoring Okinawa's famous dishes. Spend the afternoon shopping and relaxing at Aeon Ryoom, a popular mall. End the day at the Southeast Botanical Gardens, where the magical Illumination transforms the gardens into a dazzling wonderland of light and color.
