8D7N WONDERFUL SEOUL TOUR

DAY 1 – ARRIVAL SEOUL INCHEON INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT

Upon arrival at Seoul Incheon International Airport, you will be greeted by our tour guide and transfer to Seoul City. Check in. Free and easy for the day.



DAY 2 – DMZ DORASAN OBSERVATORY TONGIL (B / L)

After breakfast in hotel, meet our guide in the lobby. Transfer to Paju for a tour of DMZ, which covers the third tunnel, Dorasan Observatory and Tongil (meaning unification) village.

Back to Seoul. Free and easy when you can spend your time shopping at Myeongdong bustling street.



DAY 3 – GYEONGBOKGUNG JONGMYO ROYAL SHRINE BUKCHON VILLAGE (B / L)

Today, after your breakfast in hotel, we take you on a tour of Seoul City covering the following:

- + Gyeongbokgung, the main palace of Joseon Dynasty (1392 – 1910)
- + National Folk Museum
- + Jongmyo Royal Shrine(World Heritage) which enshrine 27 King's ancestral tablet of Joseon Dynasty.
- + Bukchon Hanok village, Hanok means Traditional Korean style of house.
- + Insadong Antique art street.
- + Gwangjang traditional market which opened its business since 1905.



DAY 4 – MT. SONGNI BEOPJUSA TEMPLE ANDONG (B / L / D)

After your breakfast in hotel, we take a drive to Mt. Songni. At Mt. Songni, visit the Beopjusa Temple (UNESCO World Heritage Site). This is the main temple of the 5th Parish of Jogye Order of Korea Buddhism. Next, we move to Andong, the City of Confucianism. Overnight in Andong Grand Hotel.



DAY 5 – ANDONG HAHOE VILLAGE MASK MUSEUM GYEONGJU (B / L)

Have breakfast in hotel, followed by a tour of Andong Hahoe Village (UNESCO World Heritage site) a well preserved architecture and folk traditions of the era of Joseon Dynasty. “Ha means river and Hoe means turn-around”. Visit the mask museum where you can see various type of Korean masks.

Then move on to another UNESCO World Heritage site, Byeongsanseowon which is a Confucian school. Transfer to Gyeongju, the 1000 year of capital city of Silla Dynasty(BC57 - AD935).

Overnight stay in Gyeongju Kolon Hotel



DAY 6 – BULGUKSA TEMPLE SEOKGURAM GROTTO TUMURI PARK CHEONGSUNGDAE (B / L)

Meet our tour guide in the lobby after your breakfast in hotel. Today, we will visit the following places in Gyeongju:

- + Bulguksa Temple (UNESCO World Heritage site) built in 528, the year after Buddhism was officially accepted by Silla Dynasty.
- + Seokguram Grotto(UNESCO World Heritage site) which first began in AD742 alongside neighbouring Bulguksa. Seokguram grotto is best known for the artificial grotto houses
- + Bulguksa completed in AD774.
- + Tumuri Park which is the site of ancient burial tombs.
- + Donggung & Wolji which was formerly known as Anapji and served as a banquet site for important national events and important visitors.
- + Cheomsungdae, astronomical observatory built in 7th century.
- + Experience making Silla pottery.

Overnight stay in Gyeongju Kolon Hotel.





DAY 7 – YONGIN FOLK VILLAGE & THEME PARK (B / L / D)

Meet our tour guide at the lobby. Our itinerary today covers Yongin. In Yongin, we will visit the Folk Village. Here in this Theme Park, we get to experience the lifestyles of the Joseon Dynasty. Transfer back to Seoul city for a sumptuous dinner. Enjoy the Royal Court Cuisine.



DAY 8 – FREE & EASY – DEPARTURE (B)

Enjoy your breakfast in hotel. Free and easy until time for transfer to Seoul Incheon International Airport for your flight departure to Singapore.
