**ITINERARY**

**DAY 01 – 19 APRIL 2025 ARRIVAL – TOKYO (LUNCH / DINNER)**

Upon arrival at Narita International Airport, meet and greet our tour guide and begin your journey in **Tokyo's Yanesen area**, a historical district encompassing Yanaka, Nezu, and Sendagi. This area is known for its old-town charm, traditional wooden houses, and serene temples. Stroll through Yanaka Ginza, a bustling shopping street offering a glimpse into Tokyo's past. Next, head to **Toyosu Senkyaku Banrai**, a vibrant complex known for its fresh seafood markets and eateries. Here, you can enjoy a delicious meal and experience the lively atmosphere of Tokyo's culinary scene. Proceed to Harajuku, exploring Takeshita Street, famous for its quirky shops, trendy

*fashion boutiques, and unique eateries. This is the heart of Tokyo's youth culture, where you can find the latest fashion trends and delicious street food.*

*If time permits, we will visit the iconic **Shibuya Crossing**, one of the busiest pedestrian intersections in the world. Experience the organized chaos of thousands of people crossing the street simultaneously. Nearby, you can explore Shibuya's vibrant shopping and entertainment district.*

**DAY 02 – 20 APRIL 2025 – TOKYO MT. FUJI + LAKE KAWAGUCHI  
(BREAKFAST / LUNCH / DINNER)**

*After breakfast in hotel, visit **Asakusa** to see the historic **Sensoji Temple**, Tokyo's oldest temple. Walk through the Nakamise Street leading up to the temple, lined with traditional shops selling souvenirs and snacks. Then head to **Tokyo Sky Tree** (view from Asakusa), the tallest structure in Japan. Enjoy panoramic views of Tokyo from the observation decks, and explore the shopping and dining options in the surrounding area. Next, visit the Iconic Mount Fuji. On the way, stop at **Oshino Hakkai**, a picturesque village known for its crystal-clear ponds fed by melted snow from Mount Fuji. Enjoy the stunning views of the mountain and explore the traditional thatched-roof houses and shops.*

**Lunch at local restaurant and Dinner in hotel.**

**DAY 03 – 21 APRIL 2025 – LAKE KAWAGUCHI + MATSUMOTO  
(BREAKFAST / LUNCH / DINNER)**

Breakfast in hotel. If weather permits, climb **to Mount Fuji Station**. Thereafter, travel to **Matsumoto**, a city surrounded by the Japanese Alps. Visit a local **miso factory** to learn about the production process of this essential Japanese seasoning and sample different varieties. In the afternoon, drive pass **Matsumoto Castle**, one of Japan's most beautiful and well-preserved castles. Known as the "Crow Castle" due to its black exterior, it offers a glimpse into Japan's feudal past.

**Lunch at local restaurant and Dinner at local restaurant.**

**Hotel: Iroha Grand Hotel Matsumoto Ekimae or similar**



**DAY 04 – 22 APRIL 2025 MATSUMOTO + ALPINE ROUTE + TOYAMA  
(BREAKFAST / LUNCH / DINNER)**

Embark on the **Alpine Route**, a scenic journey through the Northern Japan Alps. This route offers breathtaking views of mountains, valleys, and pristine nature. You'll experience various modes of transportation, including cable cars, buses, and ropeways, providing a unique and memorable adventure.

**Lunch at local restaurant and Dinner at local restaurant.**

**Hotel: Oaks Canal Park Hotel Toyama or similar**



**DAY 05 – 23 APRIL 2025 – TOYAMA + SHIRAKAWAGO + TAKAYAMA  
(BREAKFAST / LUNCH / DINNER)**

After breakfast in hotel, transfer to **Shirakawago**. Take a day trip to **Shirakawago Village**, a UNESCO World Heritage site known for its traditional gassho-zukuri farmhouses. These thatched-roof houses are designed to withstand heavy snowfall and offer a unique glimpse into Japan's rural life. Next visit **Takayama**, a city known for its well-preserved Edo-period streets. Explore the **Old Street Town of Sannomachi**, lined with traditional wooden houses, sake breweries, and shops.

**Hotel: Hida Hotel Plaza or similar**



**DAY 06 – 24 APRIL 2025 – TAKAYAMA + NARA DEER PARK + KYOTO  
(BREAKFAST / LUNCH / DINNER)**

In the morning after breakfast, early check out. Proceed to Nara Deer Park which is about 4.5 hours drive depending on traffic conditions. Nara Deer Park in Japan is a scenic area where over a thousand friendly, free-roaming deer reside. These sacred deer, considered messengers of the gods, eagerly interact with visitors, especially for special deer crackers. The park also features ancient temples and beautiful, expansive greenery, creating a serene cultural experience. On the way, break for lunch in local restaurant.

**Hotel: Miyaka Hotel Kyoto Hachijo or similar**



**DAY 07 - 25 APRIL 2025 – KYOTO – OSAKA**  
**(BREAKFAST / LUNCH / DINNER)**

Breakfast in hotel. Check out. While in **Kyoto**, Japan's ancient capital, visit the iconic **Kiyomizu Temple**, known for its wooden stage that offers stunning views of the city.

**OPTIONAL:** Wearing the Traditional Japanese Kimono dress for group photograph at Kiyomizu Temple. Rental of Kimono dress: S\$38 per person.

Explore the Yasaka area, home to the beautiful Yasaka Pagoda. Wander through the charming streets, lined with traditional shops and tea houses, and soak in the historical atmosphere. Visit the **Arashiyama Bamboo Grove**, a mesmerizing forest of towering bamboo stalks. Walk through the serene pathways and experience the tranquil beauty of this natural wonder. Nearby, visit the **Togetsukyo Bridge**, a picturesque landmark spanning the Katsura River. Enjoy the scenic views of the surrounding mountains and river. Transfer to **Osaka City**.

**DAY 08 - 26 APRIL 2025 – OSAKA CITY**  
**(BREAKFAST / LUNCH / DINNER)**

Breakfast in hotel. In the morning, while in Osaka, a vibrant city known for its modern architecture, nightlife, and street food, visit the **Umeda Sky Building** and its **Floating Garden Observatory**, offering panoramic views of the city. Explore **Osaka Castle Park**, home to the historic Osaka Castle surrounded by lush greenery. Visit **Kuromon Market**, known as "Osaka's Kitchen," to sample a variety of fresh seafood and local delicacies. Finally, end your trip with shopping and dining in the **Shinsaibashi and Dotonbori areas**. These bustling districts are famous for their vibrant atmosphere, neon lights, and an array of shops, restaurants, and entertainment options.

## DAY 01 – 19 APRIL (LUNCH / DINNER)

抵达成田国际机场后，与我们的导游会合，开始您在东京的Yanesen地区之旅。Yanesen地区涵盖了谷中、根津和千駄木，是一个历史悠久的街区，以其古老的城镇魅力、传统的木制房屋和宁静的寺庙而闻名。漫步在谷中银座，这是一条繁忙的购物街，让您一窥东京的过去。

接下来，前往丰洲千客万来，这是一个以新鲜海鲜市场和餐馆而闻名的充满活力的综合体。在这里，您可以享受美味的餐点，并体验东京美食的热闹氛围。然后前往原宿，探索竹下通，这条街以其奇特的商店、时尚精品店和独特的餐馆而闻名。这里是东京青年文化的中心，您可以找到最新的时尚潮流和美味的街头小吃。

## DAY 02 – 20 APRIL (BREAKFAST / LUNCH / DINNER)

在酒店享用早餐后，前往浅草参观历史悠久的浅草寺，这是东京最古老的寺庙。漫步在通往寺庙的仲见世街，这条街上排列着出售纪念品和小吃的传统商店。然后前往东京晴空塔，这是日本最高的建筑物。从观景台享受东京的全景视野，并探索周围区域的购物和餐饮选择。接下来，参观标志性的富士山。途中停在忍野八海，这个风景如画的村庄因其由富士山融雪汇集而成的清澈池塘而闻名。在这里，您可以欣赏到富士山的壮丽景色，探索传统的茅草屋顶房屋和商店。

## DAY 03 - 21 APRIL (BREAKFAST / LUNCH / DINNER)

在酒店享用早餐。如果天气允许，登上富士山站。随后前往被日本阿尔卑斯山环绕的松本市。参观当地的味噌工厂，了解这种重要的日本调味品的生产过程，并品尝各种不同的味噌。下午，探索松本城，这是日本最美丽和保存最完好的城堡之一。由于其黑色外观，它被称为“乌鸦城”，为您提供了一个了解日本封建历史的机会。

## DAY 04 – 22 APRIL (BREAKFAST / LUNCH / DINNER)

踏上阿尔卑斯路线，这是一条穿越日本北部阿尔卑斯山的风景优美的旅程。这条路线提供了令人叹为观止的山脉、山谷和纯净自然景观的美景。您将体验多种交通方式，包括缆车、巴士和索道，为您提供一次独特而难忘的冒险。

## DAY 05 – 23 APRIL (BREAKFAST / LUNCH / DINNER)

在酒店享用早餐后，前往白川乡。白川乡村庄是一日游的理想目的地，它是联合国教科文组织的世界遗产，以其传统的合掌造农舍而闻名。这些茅草屋顶的房屋设计用来抵御大雪，为您提供了一个独特的机会来了解日本的乡村生活。

接下来，参观高山市，这座城市以保存完好的江户时代街道而著称。探索三之町古街，这条街道两旁是传统的木制房屋、清酒酿酒厂和商店。

## DAY 06 – 24 APRIL (BREAKFAST / LUNCH / DINNER)

早晨吃过早餐后，早点退房。前往奈良鹿公园，视交通情况大约需要4.5小时车程。日本的奈良鹿公园是一个风景优美的地区，居住着一千多只友好且自由漫步的鹿。这些神圣的鹿被视为神的使者，特别喜欢与游客互动，尤其是为了获得特别的鹿饼干。公园内还有古老的寺庙和美丽广阔的绿地，营造出一种宁静的文化体验。途中在当地餐馆停下来吃午餐。

## DAY 07 – 25 APRIL (BREAKFAST / LUNCH / DINNER)

在酒店享用早餐后办理退房手续。游览京都这座古都，参观标志性的清水寺，以其木制舞台而闻名，从这里可以欣赏到城市的壮丽景色，尤其是在樱花季和秋季红叶时节。

**可选：**在清水寺穿传统的日本和服进行集体拍照。和服租赁费用：每人38新加坡元。

探索八坂地区，这里有美丽的八坂塔。漫步在充满魅力的街道上，这些街道两旁是传统的商店和茶馆，感受历史的氛围。参观岚山竹林，这是一片迷人的竹林，竹子高耸入云。在宁静的小径上漫步，体验这一自然奇观的静谧之美。附近参观渡月桥，这是一座横跨桂川的风景如画的地标。欣赏周围群山和河流的美景。之后前往大阪市。

## DAY 08 – 26 APRIL (BREAKFAST / LUNCH / DINNER)

在酒店享用早餐。早上，游览大阪，这座以现代建筑、夜生活和街头美食闻名的活力城市。参观梅田天空大厦及其空中庭院观景台，欣赏城市的全景。探索大阪城公园，这里有历史悠久的大阪城，周围绿树成荫。参观黑门市场，被称为“大阪的厨房”，在这里可以品尝各种新鲜海鲜和当地美食。

最后，在心斋桥和道顿堀地区购物和用餐。这些繁忙的街区以其充满活力的氛围、霓虹灯和各种商店、餐馆以及娱乐选择而闻名。
